What is Health Literacy?

- Health literacy is how doctors, patients, and the medical community communicate, understand, obtain, and use medical information
- Holistic term referring to both patients, medical professionals, pharmaceutical companies, and insurance firms

What is Cultural Competency?

- Ability to effectively and meaningfully communicate across various cultures
- Recognition of the varieties of cultural factors, including although not limited to:
 - Race, ethnicity, nationality
 - Language, education
 - Occupation, socio-economic status
 - Religion

What is Clear Health Communication?

 Set of standards, ideas, and techniques that promote effective and clear communication from and to both medical professionals and patients
