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## Editorial and Submission Policies:

This journal is a quarterly publication produced by Kluwer Law International in association with the Southern Methodist University Dedman School of Law's International Law Review Association (and its Law Institute of the Americas), as well as the Section of International Law and Practice of the American Bar Association. The journal relies on the ongoing cooperation of the SMU School of Business, the SMU Departments of Economics and Political Science, and the London Forum of International Economic and Financial Law at the Centre for Commercial Law Studies at Queen Mary College, University of London.
