Jeswald W. Salacuse

The *Journal of Air Law and Commerce* is pleased to announce that Jeswald W. Salacuse has been selected to be the Dean of the School of Law of Southern Methodist University. Professor Salacuse will assume the deanship on August 15, 1980. Dean Designate Salacuse received his Juris Doctor degree from Harvard University in 1963. A member of the New York State Bar, the American Society of International Law, the Order of the Coif, and other professional organizations, he has served as the Chairman of the Committee on Law and Social Science in the Middle East of the Social Science Research Council, as well as a consultant to the Ford Foundation and the United States Agency for International Development. During his academic career, as a Visiting Scholar at the Harvard University Law School and as a Professor at Southern Methodist University School of Law, Dean Designate Salacuse has specialized in the area of international business, with an emphasis on developing countries. In addition to his authorship of several books, monographs and articles on various aspects of international law, he has provided lectures to advanced legal education programs. His article which was presented at the Fourteenth Annual Air Law Symposium is published in this issue of the *Journal*. We are pleased to welcome Dean Designate Salacuse as he assumes his new duties.
