On June 25 and 26 an Institute on the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 was held at the Southern Methodist University School of Law. Considerable interest was aroused because the Code was in the process of being enacted into law by Congress. Around 550 persons attended the Institute.

An Institute on Probate and Trust Law is being planned for October 28 and 29. Announcements of the program are already in the mail.

A full graduate program for the Fall Semester has been announced. The Law Institute of the Americas will continue, and an enrollment of 20 students from the Republics to the south is expected.
